1. Camp Fee?

2. What will be provided?

Cabins will contain bunk beds to sleep with heating system. Restrooms will share among group of people. For Saturday, Breakfast, lunch, snack and dinner for Sunday breakfast and lunch will be provided

3. What to Bring?

- Sleeping Bag, pillow, comforter
- Pair of comfortable clothes for outdoors, Jacket, extra pair of socks
- Comfortable shoes for walking and hiking.
- Traditional Indian dress for Ranjan Sabha (cultural program)
- Personal hygiene items like, tooth brush, tongue cleaner, soap, towel
- Any medicines that you have to take regularly
- Water bottle to prevent dehydration.
